

ARCHITECT ROBERT STEPHENS ON 200 UNREALISED URBAN PROJECTS OF MUMBAI CITY

BOMBAY HAD THE OPPORTUNITY TO BUILD A NEW BOMBAY. WHAT ARE THE HIGHLIGHTS?

It is an intense question. It was to be a twin city but two decades ago a Rotarian suggested it should be 25 coastal cities. Bombay needs to decentralise.

WHAT ARE YOUR VIEWS ON THE UNDERGROUND, THE SEALINK AND GOING UNDERNEATH WALKESHWAR TUNNEL?

The Coastal Road plan is outdated, based on a plan in the 1960s. The Metro plan was also suggested then, the design in 1962 mentioned looking for a space for the carshed if it ever came to be. And look how it is creating a problem today.

WHY DID YOU CHOOSE BOMBAY FOR THE BOOK?

Bombay is home and Bombay has such a gravity of creative ideas, it can't be compared. Ahmedabad is next.

ONE RADICAL IDEA

I like a lot of micro plans by architect Alan Abraham and his wife. They take little corners of the city that are forgotten, and they make them meaningful places. In my opinion, micro is the way to go. The city needs that touch. OUT OF THE 200 UNREALISED PROJECTS WHICH ARE THE ONES THAT CAN TAKE OFF? AND ANY PROJECT THAT TALKS ABOUT A CITY GOING UNDERWATER AND SOMETHING ON THAT?

The second project in the book says building a channel from Mahalaxmi to Mazgaon as a funnel of the ocean as opposed to confronting headon. Out of the 200 unrealised projects, Banganga cremation has potential, it can be done.

We create new challenges, it's a challenging proposition that should be done very carefully.

AY TO OPEN THIRD CENTRE IN MAZGAON

There are countless underprivileged elders in central Mumbai who live in little tenements of under 300 sq. ft. With the pressure on space so severe, the elders sometimes end up getting treated like unwanted furniture.

Ananda Yaan (a mission to happiness) is aimed at being that ray of sunlight that brings an element of happiness to these elders in the evening of their lives.

With Dignity Foundation as our partner, Ananda Yaan was launched in 2017 with one centre at Byculla. Marathi actor Nina Joshi was present. Since then it has spread its wings to Dr. E. Moses Road and is now poised to open a third centre in Mazgaon.

Ananda Yaan provides elders with a structured programme three hours a day, five days a week. The activities in this time include yoga, zumba, antakshari, celebrating birthdays of members, and performing skits.

Ananda Seva is an activity where Rotarians can celebrate red letter days on their calendars by providing these elders with a treat. Many Rotarians love the idea and sponsor a lunch, or a chaat meal, tickets to a music show or a picnic.

VAIDU CHILDREN PERFORM PLAYS ACROSS GANESH MANDALS TO INCREASE AWARENESS OF ALCOHOLISM

Alcoholism has led to an increase in crimes, illiteracy, and domestic violence in the Vaidu tribal community. The basic needs of many families, like food, clothes, and education remain thus unaddressed. To overcome this, Rotary Club of Bombay in association with Rotary Club of Addiction Prevention, has started an alcohol de-addiction programme.

To increase awareness of the pitfalls of alcoholism, young tribal children put together a play and enacted it across 97 Ganesh mandaps from August 31st to September 10th, 2022. At each location, around 60 to 70 people saw the young actors performing and spreading the message.

Many mandals awarded our children's performances by

giving them coconuts, shawls and envelopes. Some people got emotional after watching the performance as they were able to relate to their own lives. There were inquiries about our Alcohol De-Addiction centres in Jogeshwari and Marol.

CASE STUDIES Omkar Melkundi Omkar is a 13-yearold boy who



studies in the 8th standard. He played the role of an alcoholic father in the play. Omkar shared that it's pretty similar to what happens in his house. His father is abusive alcoholic. Omkar is trying to enrol his father in the deaddiction programme.

EXPERIENCE AT PMGP COLONY MANDAL

After the performance in PMGP colony, Mr. Shivaji Jadhav, the President of the PMGP colony, gave prizes to the children. He had tears in his eyes and shared that his son was addicted to alcohol and other toxic substances. He wants to help his son be free from these habits. Shivaji was very curious about RCB's alcohol de-addiction centres and promised that he will bring his son to them.
