TALWADA MEDICAL CENTRE

In celebration of its 24th anniversary, Talwada Medical Centre provided free medical services to around 18,000 patients, including farmers, daily wage laborers, and Adivasis. Services offered covered dental, pediatric, tuberculosis, pathology, and general medicine.

The Talwada medical centre Committee recently launched a new Well Baby Clinic, offering specialized kits containing nutritional information, supplements, nappies, blankets, and towels to new mothers.

Our Medical Officer Dr. Ashwini Bhusara attends daily to patients with routine medical problems. Additionally, regular visits and consultation are provided by Rtn. (Dr.) Rohini Chowgule, Paediatrician Dr. Bijoy Apte and a team consisting of Dr. Srinivas Kamath, Dr. Ajay Gupta and Dr. Neeraj Kolge along with Rotaractors of Government Dental College.

Additionally, ADMC coordinated the development of an eco-friendly playground constructed with recyclable materials, now located in the front garden for local children. Moreover, a roof has been installed on the terrace, transforming it into a functional space for the community.

- Pediatric care**
ADMC focuses on the medical care and treatment of infants, children, and adolescents. Pediatrics is dedicated to diagnosing and managing a range of child-related health conditions, including those requiring specialized care in the Pediatric ward. An average of 48 patients benefit each month.
- TB Treatment**
Tuberculosis is a serious infectious disease that requires prompt diagnosis and treatment. At ADMC, we offer comprehensive TB treatment services to help patients recover and prevent the spread of the disease. X-rays are also performed at the center to assess the extent of infection spread. An average of 81 patients benefit each month.
- Pathological Tests**
ADMC offers a wide range of pathological tests to help our healthcare providers make informed decisions about your health. From blood tests and imaging studies to specialized genetic testing, our laboratory is equipped to handle a variety of diagnostic tests with precision and efficiency. An average of 40 patients benefit each month.

Accessibility: Located in the heart of the community, the medical centre is easily accessible to everyone, making it convenient for people to seek medical attention when needed.

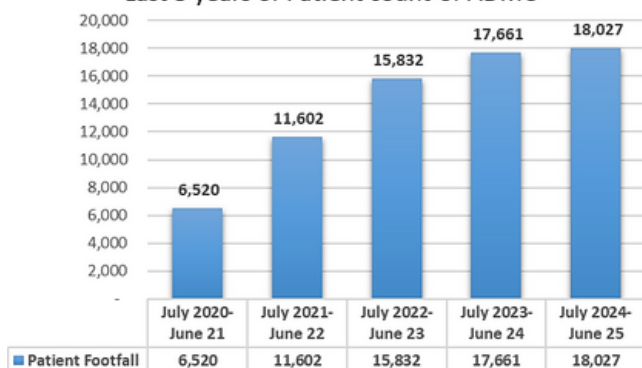
Affordability: The centre offers affordable healthcare services, ensuring that even those from underprivileged backgrounds can access treatment without worrying about the cost.

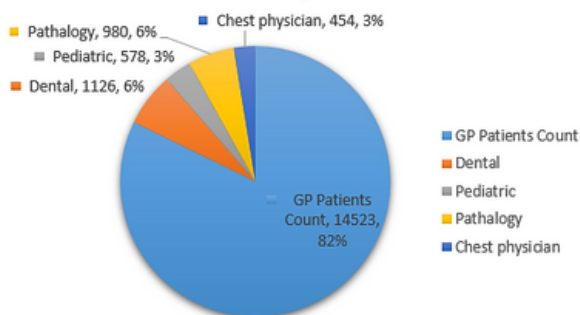
STATISTICS OF TALWADA MEDICAL CENTER (ADMC)

Last 5 years of Patient count of ADMC

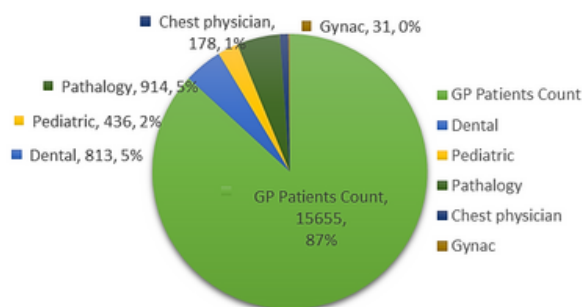


TOTAL PATIENTS FOOTFALL
