## The Healing Touch

In the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Rotary Club of Bombay witnessed the urgent need for dialysis services among the most vulnerable members of society. Patients with Chronic Kidney Disease were facing unprecedented challenges in accessing life-saving treatment due to travel restrictions, fear, and financial hardship. The Rotary Club of Bombay knew they had to take action to address this critical issue and ensure that these patients received the care they desperately needed.

With a deep sense of empathy and responsibility, the Dialysis Committee of the Rotary Club of Bombay embarked on a mission to establish a network of dialysis centres that would provide comprehensive care to patients in need. The vision for the year 2025-26 was clear: to expand access to dialysis services, improve patient outcomes, and transform lives through compassionate care.

### The Journey Begins

In March 2020, the Rotary Club of Bombay made a commitment to support dialysis centres in the region. This initiative was met with overwhelming support from the community, as donors, partners, and volunteers came together to make a difference. Through their collective efforts, the Rotary Club of Bombay was able to establish 15 dialysis centres, install 90 dialysis machines, and deliver over 1.4 lac dialysis cycles in just a few short years.

### A Vision for Holistic, Human-Centered Care

High cost and urban-centric care make dialysis unaffordable and inaccessible for many Indians. Without change, thousands remain at risk of prevention loss. Dialysis is essential for patients with end-stage kidney disease. Yet in India, it remains out of reach for many. High cost and limited availability often force patients to delay or discontinue treatment, sometimes with fatal consequences. To date, the Rotary Club of Bombay has donated 90 dialysis machines in multiple hospitals with German cutting-edge machines with automatic blood pressure monitoring systems to eliminate human errors. beyond that, we are working towards centres of care that offer: - Nutritional guidance during dialysis. We have nephrologists on call and technicians available throughout. Also Conducting Awareness sessions on diabetes, blood pressure, and lifestyle changes.



## ACHIEVEMENTS

### 90 MACHINES IN 15 DIALYSIS CENTRES

The Rotary Club of Bombay has established 15 dialysis centres across Palghar and Mumbai, located in areas such as Manor, Ghatkopar, and Borivali. These centres provide free or heavily subsidized treatment to alleviate the financial and emotional strain on patients, easing the burden of kidney disease for hundreds of families.

## STORIES OF HOPE

In Palghar regions where dialysis machines have been donated, the transformation is profound. Rural hospitals once forced to turn away patients can now offer consistent treatment. Families no longer have to travel long distances or sell their possessions to afford care. Each machine becomes a symbol of hope, compassion, and global solidarity.



## WHY IS DIALYSIS SO EXPENSIVE?

The financial burden of dialysis is significant. Each session can cost between Rs. 1,500 and 4,000, and with multiple sessions required per week, the monthly cost for 12 sessions is approximately. Rs. 40,000 thousand. further tests, hospitalization, and medical costs are additional expenses to the patient.

Keeping this fact in mind, the Rotary Club of Bombay is taking care of the entire dialysis burden, which could be anywhere btw Rs. 18,000 to 54,000 a month.

## KEY BENEFITS OF DIALYSIS MACHINE DONATIONS

- **Increased Access to Treatment:** Donations expand the capacity of healthcare facilities, allowing more patients to receive life-sustaining care.
- **Reduced Financial Burden:** Patients and hospitals benefit from reduced costs, making treatment more affordable and sustainable.
- **Improved Health Outcomes:** Regular access to dialysis improves survival rates, quality of life, and the ability of patients to return to work or education.
- **Strengthened Healthcare Systems:** Donations often come with training and technical support, enhancing the skills of medical staff and improving overall healthcare delivery.

## NEED OF THE HOUR

Our medical facility is currently in need of an additional dialysis machines to accommodate the growing number of patients requiring this critical treatment. With the cost of a new dialysis machine amounting to Rs. 7.5 lacs, we are recurrently reaching out to our community for support in raising the necessary funds to make this purchase possible.

A centre of 10 machines can also be sponsored by a donor for around 1 crore rupees where in the centre would carry the name of the donor and RCB.
