UNDERSTANDING CORONARY HEART DISEASE (CHD)

Coronary Heart Disease is the term that describes what happens when your heart's blood supply is blocked or interrupted by a build-up of fatty substances in the coronary arteries. Over time, the walls of your arteries can become furred up with fatty deposits.

CONGENITAL HEART DISEASE

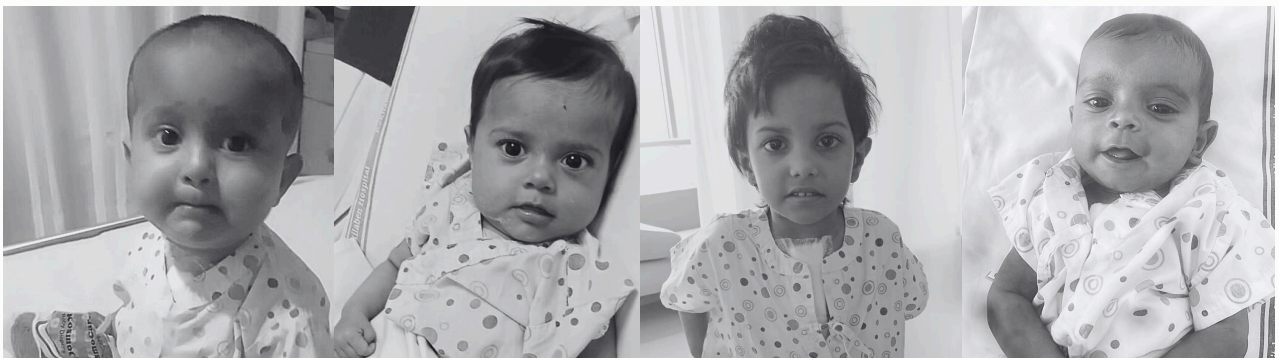
CHD, or congenital heart disease, refers to problems or defects of the heart that happened while the heart was developing in a baby before birth. The heart defects vary and can affect the valves, the walls of the heart, or the blood vessels (veins and arteries) surrounding the heart.

Congenital Heart Disease (CHD) is a prevalent health issue in India, with increasing rates of diagnosis and mortality. More than 2,00,000 children are born in India each year with CHD and related health complications, equating to 8-10 cases for every 1000 births. Unfortunately, approximately 1/5th of these children require medical intervention within their first year of life, and a staggering 90% lack access to the quality healthcare they desperately need.

Rotary Club of Bombay's Mission

In partnership with leading hospitals in Mumbai, the Rotary Club of Bombay is on a mission to eliminate these roadblocks and provide guidance and financial assistance to families in need. Our partner hospitals offer special subsidized rates for CHD treatment without compromising on the quality of care. With world-class facilities and renowned doctors, patients can be assured of receiving the best possible treatment for their condition.

Through regular health camps organized across India, the Rotary Club of Bombay identifies children with CHD and evaluates the urgency and type of medical assistance required. Once a case is brought to our attention, our team vets the necessary documents and takes over the coordination of care. This ensures that patients receive the attention and support they need to overcome this life-threatening condition.





Total Beneficiaries Covered

In the Rotary year 2024- 2025, a total of **360** surgeries have been performed at a cost of Rs **4.74 Cr.** (average per surgery is Rs. **1.3 Lac**)

Since the inception of the project in 2018, a total of **1114 cases** have been supported from the **6 partnered hospitals**, highlighting the impact of accessible healthcare services.

Action Plan For The Upcoming Year 2025-26

•RCB has partnered with multiple hospitals including Kokilaben Dhirubhai Ambani Hospital, SRCC children's hospital & Shri Sathya Sai Sanjeevani Hospital to provide financial assistance to children from economically backward families, suffering from CHD.

•Each hospital has provided RCB subsidized rates for surgical/medical interventions which enable us to help the families at little or no cost to them.

•Each of our partner hospitals boasts state of the art facilities and provide access to world class medical treatment.

•Through our ongoing global grants we aim to complete at least 250 surgeries in the coming year. We intend to raise further funds to enable us to expand our reach.

•We have successfully supported over 1110 surgeries in the last 6 years under this project.

•In the last Rotary year we have supported 360 surgeries at a total cost of Rs. 4,74,54,859/- we have supported children as young as a few hours old upto 18 years of age.
