The evening brought together Rotary leaders, dignitaries, members, partners and friends in celebration of the Club's enduring legacy and its vision for the future.

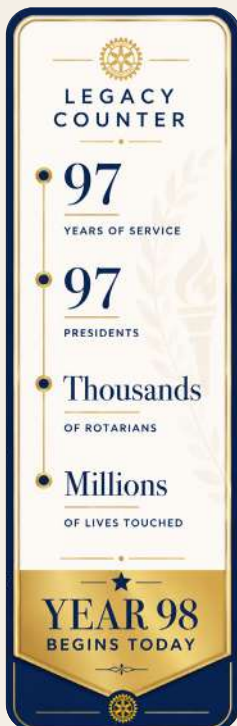
The formal proceedings commenced with President Manish Reshamwala calling the meeting to order and warmly welcoming the distinguished gathering, including Rotary International Director KP Nagesh (represented through his message), District Governor Rajan

Dua, First Lady Preeti Dua, Past District Governor Sandip Agarwalla, the College of Governors, district dignitaries and the Rotary family.

Immediate Past President Rtn. Bimal Mehta officially handed over the mantle of leadership, reflecting on a remarkable year while expressing complete confidence in his successor. Introducing the year's theme, "Where Service Becomes Legacy," he described it as both a tribute to the Club's proud heritage and a call to build upon it. In one of the evening's memorable lines, he reminded everyone:

"Legacy is not a weight to carry. It is a torch to raise higher."

The ceremonial exchange of the President's and Immediate Past President's pins symbolised a seamless transition, followed by the felicitation of District Governor Rajan Dua and First Lady Preeti Dua. The newly installed Board of Directors, Satellite Club Board members, District office-bearers and the dedicated Rotary Club of Bombay staff were then introduced and recognised, reflecting the depth of leadership that supports the Club's work.



One of the most heartfelt moments of the evening came during President Manish's introduction. A touching video message from his father, Past President Rajnikant Reshamwala, set the tone before his daughter, **Rtn. Anushka Reshamwala**, offered a warm, personal glimpse into the man behind the office. Sharing stories of family, friendship and service, she painted the picture of a leader whose greatest strength lies in connecting with people.

Her words resonated deeply with the audience:

"For him, Rotary has never been about the title. It's always been about the friendships, the relationships and the opportunity to quietly make a difference, one person at a time."

President Manish Reshamwala then delivered his inaugural address, outlining an ambitious vision for the year centred on collaboration, continuity and meaningful impact under the banner of Where Service Becomes Legacy.

- Project strengthens Rotary Club of Bombay's commitment to affordable renal care



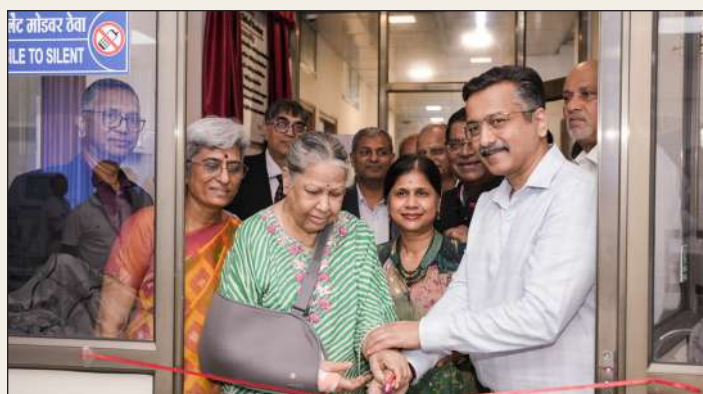
The Rotary Club of Bombay marked another milestone in its healthcare initiatives with the inauguration of its 19th Dialysis Centre at Mukta Kidney & Dialysis Clinic, Bandra West, on 9th July, 2026.

With the donation of 13 state-of-the-art dialysis machines, the Club's cumulative contribution has now reached 118 machines across 19 centres, further strengthening access to quality and affordable dialysis care for patients with chronic kidney disease.

The centre was inaugurated by Shri Ashish Shelar, Cabinet Minister of Information Technology & Cultural Affairs, Government of Maharashtra, in the presence of distinguished guests including Smt.

Prajakta Verma, Additional Municipal Commissioner (City & Health); District Governor Rtn. Rajan Dua; IPDG Dr. Manish Motwani; PDG Sandip Agarwalla; IPP Bimal Mehta; President Manish Reshamwala; Dr. Jyotsna Zope, Director of Mukta Kidney & Dialysis Clinic; Rtn. Josy Paul is the Chairman and Chief Creative Officer of BBDO India, the agency he co-founded in 2008 from the backseat of his car. Over nearly two decades, he has established himself as one of India's most celebrated creative leaders, crafting iconic campaigns such as Whisper – Touch the Pickle, Ariel – Share the Load, Gillette – Women Against Lazy Stubble, and WhatsApp – Oye Lucky. His work has earned more than 25 Cannes Lions, including a Grand Prix and multiple Gold awards, while Ariel was recognised by WARC as the world's most effective campaign.

Before launching BBDO India, Josy was National Creative Director at JWT and founded David, Ogilvy's challenger agency, in India. His many honours include Campaign Asia's Creative Person of the Year, Asia-Pacific Creative Leader of the Year, and induction into the Advertising Club Calcutta Hall of Fame. Guided by his philosophy, "Think like the navy, deliver like the pirates," Josy continues to create work that inspires conversations, influences culture, and drives meaningful social change.
